Ordinance # 20210812-01 Ordinance to Designate Class B Highway

The Town Board of the Town of Rock, Wood County Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.159 (2), Wis stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting, and proper notice having been given, designates town highway as a class "B" highway in the town as follows.

- A. The following town highway in the Town of Rock is designated a Class "B" highway subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.19 (2), Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance. Bluff Drive East of Wood County Highway B to the Township Boundary of Lincoln Avenue.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described roadway on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highway in violation of the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. Stats. Upon conviction of a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of \$100 (one hundred dollars and no cents), plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the Town Board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective September 1, 2021. The Town Clerk shall properly publish and post this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
